

## Viewing Dynamic (XFA-based) PDF forms in Mozilla Firefox or Google Chrome

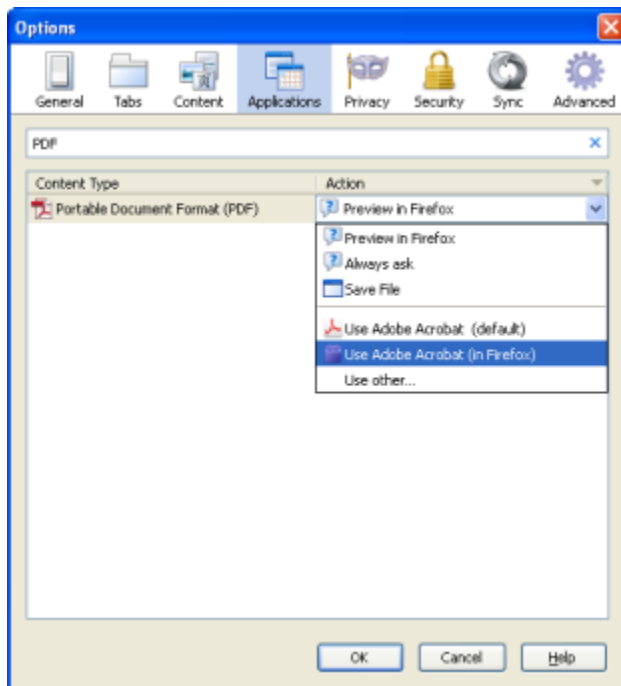
Venture Bank uses dynamic PDF forms for some applications and agreements to increase ease of use for clients. In some instances Mozilla Firefox and Google Chrome browsers are not configured appropriately to view these form. The following directions will walk you through how to adjust the settings on your browser to allow dynamic PDF forms to be viewed. ### To Configure Firefox

1. In Firefox, choose **Tools > Options**.
2. In the Options dialog, click **Applications**.
3. In the Applications tab, type PDF in the search field.
4. For Portable Document Format (PDF) content type in the search result, select **Use Adobe Acrobat (in Firefox)** from the Action drop-down list.



5. Click **OK**.
6. Restart Firefox.
7. After configuring, the first time you attempt to view a PDF form, you may encounter the following screen:

## To Configure Chrome

1. In URL Address bar in Chrome, navigate to **chrome://plugins/**. (There must be a period at the end of this address.)
2. Click **Disable** under Chrome PDF Viewer, and click **Enable** under Adobe PDF Plug-In.
